

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

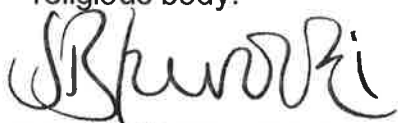
1. The name of the school is **Clearwell Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school
3. The name of the governing body is **"The governing body of Clearwell Church of England Primary School"**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - 2 parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 headteacher
 - 2 foundation governors
 - 3 co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors **10**
6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Mid-Wyedean Churches Parochial Church Council.
7.
 - (a) the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The principal officiating minister of the Mid-Wyedean Churches.
 - (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of an ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which the governorship exists, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.

9. A Trust exists which relates to the school, the Trustees being the Vicar and Churchwardens.
10. Clearwell Church of England Controlled Primary School has a Christian foundation, which it seeks to promote by providing high quality education for all its pupils. Its ethos is underpinned by Christian values, which by experience and example provide a basis for lifelong learning.
11. The instrument of government came into effect on 1st June 2015.
12. A varied instrument of government comes into effect on 1st January 2018.
13. The instrument was varied by order of Gloucestershire County Council

on 22.12.2017

14. A copy of the consolidated instrument must be supplied free of charge to every member and associate member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), as well as, where relevant, the trustees of any foundation, the appropriate diocesan authority and appropriate religious body.
